From the Trip Coordinator:

**Sun Valley, Idaho Ski Trip**  
**January 27-February 3, 2019**

**Important Information:** Due to air schedule changes by three Airlines, our non-stop schedules on the original **Saturday to Saturday** trip were changed to include a stopover in Phoenix, AZ, both going to Boise, ID and returning to O'Hare Airport. The time period between plane changes was so short that the trip committee decided to change the trip to a **Sunday to Sunday** trip with a round trip United Airlines non-stop flight.

This trip includes round trip airfare on United Airlines, ground transportation to/from the lodging, a multi-day ski area lift ticket, and lodging in 2 or 3 bed/bath condominiums. The lodging is in the Deluxe Lodge Apartments (Condominiums), located next to the Sun Valley Lodge. A stop for lunch and grocery shopping is included along with valet service for your lodging luggage, and a welcome reception. A final group dinner is in the planning stages for Friday evening, February 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Registrations for this trip are now available.** The first of four scheduled payments is due on August 14<sup>th</sup>. Your total trip price is calculated by adding the "Base Price" to your selected number of lift ticket costs. Your initial trip payment, along with the completed trip registration, waiver, and membership forms (available on our website [www.snowseekers.org](http://www.snowseekers.org)) will reserve your place on this trip. This trip is planned for a maximum of 36 Snowseekers members. The final payment is due by November 13, 2018. No scheduled group airfares will be available after October 28, 2018.
