From the Trip Coordinator:

2020 Western Ski Trip
Snowmass, Colorado
February 29 to March 7, 2020

The Snowmass 2020 trip is almost filled. I have room for a single female, and a single male which will fill two of the spots still available. One 2 bed, 2 bath condo has only two people wanting to go on the trip. I cannot accommodate them until two more people fill the condo. I will need a couple, or two single males, or two single females to fill the remaining condo openings. A trip deposit and completion of the trip registration, waiver, and membership forms will be required to secure the final places on the trip.

The trip deposit and completed forms were due in July. Your final trip payment must be received by October 8th. Visit the website www.Snowseekers.org to find the forms needed for registration. The forms are found under “Documents, Newsletters, and Forms”. They can be filled out online on our website. Please send the complete forms with your payment to the Trip Coordinator.

The maximum number of participants for this trip has been expanded to 40. We already have 34 people signed up for this trip. The remaining six lodging spots are now available based on the type of vacancy (see paragraph one above) needed to fill two single lodging spots, and one remaining two bed condo.

PRE-EXISTING CONDITION EXCLUSION WAIVER

Pre-existing medical conditions are eligible for coverage when:

- Plan is purchased at or before final trip payment
- Full trip cost is insured
- The traveler is medically able to travel at the time of plan purchase

A pre-existing condition is an Injury, Sickness or other condition (excluding any condition from which death ensues) of an Insured, Traveling Companion, Business Partner or Family Member which, within the 60 day period immediately preceding and including the Insured's coverage effective date.

This exclusion applies to those not traveling.
