Friday, January 3, 2020

Lodging--- the regular check-in time is 4:00 pm. Your room might be ready early, but the 4:00 pm check-in time is normal. **Each room must have a credit card registered at the front desk in the Lobby. Lift tickets and rental slips for the weekend will be in your packets when you check in on Friday.**

6:00pm to 8:00pm—pizza will be provided by the Snowseekers Ski Club in Dante's Restaurant for registered guests staying overnight on Friday.

PRE-EXISTING CONDITION EXCLUSION WAIVER

Pre-existing medical conditions are eligible for coverage when:

- Plan is purchased at or before final trip payment
- Full trip cost is insured
- The traveler is medically able to travel at the time of plan purchase

A pre-existing condition is an Injury, Sickness or other condition (excluding any condition from which death ensues) of an Insured, Traveling Companion, Business Partner or Family Member which, within the 60 day period immediately preceding and including the Insured's coverage effective date.

This exclusion applies to those not traveling.
